A series of events are being arranged to allow us to find out more about what happens when someone dies, why it is important to write a Will, and a chance to ask and explore issues surrounding our own and others death.

The first session will be held at St John's Deaf Club, Green Lanes on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February at 7pm when a local funeral director will explain about what happens when someone dies and what a funeral director does.

**Did you know...** that we eat pancakes on the day before Lent, to use up all the rich foods such as butter, eggs and sugar before giving them up for Lent?


