St Paul's Cathedral, Patronal Festival, 23rd January 4.30pm

A Service of Holy Communion to celebrate their patron saint, Paul. The service will be interpreted and anyone is welcome to come.



What is a Patronal Festival?

All churches in the Church of England and Catholic traditions are dedicated to a particular saint or saints. This saint becomes the patron of the church and it is hoped that they will look after the church and congregation. More importantly, as church members, we look to follow the Christian life and dedication of that saint and be more like him.

St Paul has two feast days... one when he became a Christian (Jan 25th) and the other at the end June (29th) when we remember the day he was killed for his faith.

Every year the church will have a special festival day to remember their saint, their Christian life and influence of other Christians down through history. St. Paul is remembered for the great teachings he gave the Church, which you can read in the New Testament of the Bible. He also died for his faith probably during the time of the Emperor Nero, when he had asked to be tried at Rome so that he could share the good news about Jesus when he was there.
