## Riandu Project

There are still parts of the world where a child who is born Deaf is considered a curse or a shame on the family. This is still true in many parts of Kenya and Deaf children are kept hidden away. This means few Deaf children get an education at all and there are very few specialist schools for Deaf children in the country.

The Riandu project is a new secondary school which when finally built will have room for at least 100 students.

During 2016 the Deaf Church have made two contributions to this project. £400 has been given from our Harvest collection and another £300 given from the BSL Christmas service at Marble Arch.

Thank you to everyone for your support in this and we will keep in touch with the school's progress over the coming years.
