St Edward the Confessor National Pilgrimage. Westminster Abbey Saturday 15th October



The Abbey celebrates its patron saint, Saint Edward the Confessor on this day. Edward was king of England from 1042-1066. He was known for his Christian life and ruling as a good King. The Abbey is closed to tourists this day

in order to allow people to visit the church in a prayerful and quiet way. There is no entry fee for this day.

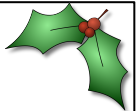

Did you know... one of the earliest Christian Bibles is kept at the British Library next to Kings Cross Station? It is called the 'Codex Sinaiticus' and was produced in 4th Century. It is handwritten and is the earliest surviving copy of the complete New Testament and some of the best copies of the Jewish scriptures.
